USE

Biokil Crown Timber Paste is a deep penetrating full-bodied emulsion for the use in eradication of wood boring insects and treatment of fungal decay.

DESCRIPTION

A deep penetrating full-bodied emulsion. Useful for the pre-treatment and the remedial treatment of large-section timber or where access is restricted or where treatment by conventional fluid methods may not be adequate i.e. Timber which is particularly prone to decay i.e. wall plates, joists and rafter ends, gutter boards, soffits, lintels etc, large cross section beams, and timbers permanently in contact with the ground.

Biokil Crown Chemicals formulations are all cleared under the Governments Pesticide Safety Precaution scheme and under the Control of Pesticide Regulations 1986, for use as directed and carries the HSE Approval No 6886.

CONTENTS

Active ingredients are Disodium Octoborate Tetrahydrate.

METHOD

Apply Biokil Crown Timber Paste to the timber by using a caulking gun or by brush, trowel or gloved hand liberally covering the surface. Injection into the timber is particularly recommended when treating Death Watch Beetle.

Preparatory works

Check the structural integrity of the timbers to be treated and remove any severely infested timber. Ensure that any new timber is treated with a suitable preservative. Ensure that cut ends of timber are also fully treated. In areas affected by fungal decay take all necessary actions to eliminate the source of dampness and to promote drying out. Thoroughly clean all timbers - vacuum cleaning preferred. Biokil Crown Timber Paste does not dry out immediately but continues to penetrate over a long period of time depending on the rate of application and the absorption characteristics of the timber. May leave a slight deposit on the surface of the treated timber. Not for use on timbers to be painted or glued.

COVERAGE

1 litre per square metre for 25mm thick timber. This figure is approximate and depends on the permeability of the timber being treated.
